## Our Work

Diversity Hub delivers training for a wide range of business, public service and voluntary sector organisations and community groups. We offer a needs analysis session prior to designing specific training programmes for organisations. Programmes include (but are not limited to) team building, welcoming and valuing diversity, conflict resolution, anger management and anti-bullying.

## Community Projects

We work with different community groups to help them better understand their peers and develop the understanding and respect needed in building sustainable communities. Diversity Hub run a programme of open community workshops on a range of diversity topics, open to anyone, regardless of their current involvement in diversity issues. Some people come because they want an introduction to the work, others come because they know they need to hone their skills so they can be more effective. Some people come from an organisation (often with other colleagues), whilst others come as an individual concerned citizen.

Our programmes are tailored so that regardless of what background and skill level, participants can take practical ideas back with them so they can work for change, either as part of a group or organisation, or as a result of their own individual initiative. We often work with those who have felt exclusion and give them the confidence to challenge convention and open up new conversations.

## Our Community Workshops include:

### Empowering Women to Take Leadership

One of the events taking place celebrating International Women's Day. The event is for women who want to take, or extend their, leadership in their organisation, place of worship, community or family.

### Welcoming and Valuing Diversity

This is a workshop for anyone who wants to understand how diversity impacts on their life, work or organisation.

### Dual Heritage workshop

This session is for anyone of Dual Heritage, Mixed Race, or who is Multi-Heritage, and their allies.

### Conflict Resolution

This workshop is for anyone who wants to understand the underlying issues when conflict presents, and the skills to tackle it.

### Pride Not Prejudice

This workshop takes place during Leicester Pride week for lesbians, gays and heterosexuals who want to be better allies in ending homophobia.
