Open Community Workshops and Training

We run a programme of open community workshops on a range of diversity topics, open to anyone, regardless of their current involvement in diversity issues. Some people come because they want an introduction to the work, others come because they know they need to hone their skills so they can be more effective. Some people come from an organisation (often with other colleagues), whilst others come as an individual concerned citizen. Our programmes are tailored so that regardless of what their background and skill level, everyone can take practical ideas back with them so they can work for change, either as part of a group or organisation, or as a result of their own individual initiative. The Community Workshops include:

Empowering Women To Take Leadership. One of the events taking place celebrating International Women's Day. The event is for women who want to take, or extend their, leadership in their organisation, place of worship, community or family.

English and British Pride - St George's Day workshop for anyone living in England exploring what it is to be English and why it's important to take pride.

Welcoming and Managing Diversity workshop for anyone who wants to understand how diversity impacts on their life, work or organisation.

Conflict Resolution workshop for anyone who wants to understand the underlying issues when conflict presents, and the skills to tackle it.

Pride Not Prejudice workshop during Leicester Pride week for lesbians, gays and heterosexuals who want to be better allies in ending homophobia.

Fathers Day workshop for men who want to look at the issues facing men particularly in their role as fathers.

Dual Heritage workshop for anyone of Dual Heritage, Mixed Race, or who is Multi-Heritage, and their allies

Families workshop for whole families or members of families who want to learn skills for tackling the tough issues they face.

Leadership Training for anyone who wants to take leadership skills back to their organisation or life so they can build community cohesion.

Healing the Racism that Divides Us during Black History Month, for anyone who wants to end racism.
